

# Caribbean Association of Pharmacists Peer Awards 2010



## CARIBBEAN COMMUNITY PHARMACIST OF DISTINCTION AWARD Sponsored by Apotex

An award to a Caribbean Community Pharmacist who in the opinion of his/her peers has served the community and provided the highest level of Pharmacy care.

The winner of this award will receive the **Secundum Artem** trophy and a 2-night stay (max. \$400 US) at the succeeding conference donated by **Apotex**

The nominee must:

- Have been a community/ retail Pharmacist for six(6) years and over
- Have worked in the same Pharmacy for three(3) years and over
- Be a member of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists (CAP)
- Be in good standing with the national professional regulatory body
- Be a member of a local national association where one exists.
- Be an active member of a service club, church group or a volunteer in civic organizations.

Any member of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists may make a nomination.

### GENERAL RULES:

These Rules apply to all Awards. See below for criteria established for specific Awards. All persons making nominations must: -

- 1) Complete the prescribed nomination form and inform the nominee for their approval
- 2) Submit form to the Secretary Treasurer of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists or the National Liaison Officer.
- 3) The forms must be submitted to CAP on or before August 10<sup>th</sup> 2010
- 4) The decision will be made by the Executive Council of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists during the meeting of the Executive Council, on the second day of the conference.
- 5) The Executive Council reserves the right to make a nomination
- 6) The announcement of the winner will be made during the Annual Awards Ceremony
- 7) The decision of the Executive Council of CAP shall be final.

**N.B. All persons who have accepted nominations must arrange to be present during the Awards Ceremony or inform CAP of the name of their representative.**
