The winner of this award will receive a trophy and citation donated by Commonwealth Drugs

Any member of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists may make a nomination.

The nominee must be a Registered Pharmacist and have displayed conduct of the highest ethical and humanitarian standards.

GENERAL RULES:

All persons making nominations must

- 1) Complete the prescribed nomination form and inform the nominee for their approval
- 2) Submit form to the Secretary Treasurer of CAP or the National Liaison Officer, where one exists .
- 3) The forms must be submitted to CAP on or before July 10th 2010
- 4) The decision will be made by the Executive Council of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists during the meeting of the Executive Council, on the second day of the conference.
- 5) The Executive Council reserves the right to make a nomination
- 6) The announcement of the winner will be made during the Annual Awards Ceremony
- 7) The decision of the Executive Council of CAP shall be final.

N.B. All persons who have accepted nominations must arrange to be present during the Awards Ceremony or inform CAP of the name of their representative.
