The winner of this award will receive the **Eureka Trophy** donated by **CARIMED**, the H.I.C Lowe Award and the **Boehringer-Ingelheim Book Award**.

Any member of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists may make a nomination.

The nominee must:

- Have a continuous and unquestionable track record of contribution exceeding five (5) years.
- Have developed a new concept, idea, technique, product or institution that has benefited Caribbean Pharmacy
- Have demonstrated commitment to the people of the Caribbean.

GENERAL RULES:

These Rules apply to all Awards. See below for criteria established for specific Awards.

All persons making nominations must: -

- 1) Complete the prescribed nomination form and inform the nominee for their approval
- 2) Submit form to the Secretary Treasurer of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists or the National Liaison Officer.
- 3) The forms must be submitted to CAP on or before July 10th 2010
- 4) The decision will be made by the Executive Council of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists during the meeting of the Executive Council, on the second day of the conference.
- 5) The Executive Council reserves the right to make a nomination
- 6) The announcement of the winner will be made during the Annual Awards Ceremony
- 7) The decision of the Executive Council of CAP shall be final.

N.B. All persons who have accepted nominations must arrange to be present during the Awards Ceremony or inform CAP of the name of their representative.
