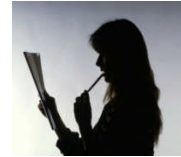


# *Caribbean Association of Pharmacists Peer Awards 2011*



## **PHARMACY PRACTICE PIONEER AWARD**

The winners of these three (3) awards will each receive an ACME trophy sponsored by **Carlisle Laboratories**. Any member of the **Caribbean Association of Pharmacists** may make a nomination.

The nominee must:

- Have been a registered Pharmacist for five (5) years and over
- Have worked in the same Pharmacy for three (3) years and over
- Be a member of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists (CAP)
- Be in good standing with the national professional or regulatory body
- Be a member of a local national association where one exists.
- Be of high moral character, good citizenship and high professionalism and who has made a significant contribution to health system pharmacy.
- Be providing a mix of clinical services or a specialization that promote the value of the cognitive skills of Pharmacists

### **Rules: All persons making nominations must**

- 1) Complete the prescribed nomination form and inform the nominee for their approval
- 2) Submit the form to the Secretariat of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists
- 3) The forms must be submitted to CAP on or before **July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011**
- 4) The decision will be made by the Executive Council of CAP
- 5) The announcement of the winner will be made during the Annual Awards Ceremony
- 6) The decision of the Executive Council of CAP shall be final.

*Note : Awardees should be selected from both the private sector and Institutional Pharmacy.*

**N.B. All persons who have accepted nominations must arrange to be present during the Awards Ceremony or inform CAP of the name of their representative.**
