THE CARIBBEAN PHARMACY SPIRIT AWARD

An award for outstanding contribution to hospital pharmacy practice to be made to an individual or institution offering service in this area.

The Winner of this award will receive:-

- ◆ The Caribbean Pharmacy Spirit Trophy donated by **Boehringer Ingelheim**
- ◆ The **Boehringer Ingelheim** Book Award

Any member of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists may make a nomination

The nominee must:-

- Be a registered pharmacist working in the hospital system in the Caribbean or a hospital/clinic/pharmacy institution in the public or private sector providing pharmacy services to the Caribbean people
- Be a member of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists or have such a pharmacist in its employ
- Be a member of a professional organization that represents pharmacy (where one exists)
- Be making an outstanding contribution to the practice of pharmacy in place of employment or engaged in outstanding service delivery
- Be recognized as an integral part of the health care team
- Exemplify equity, access, honesty, caring and adherence to the law in the delivery of service to the public.

Rules:-

All persons making nominations must:-

1. Complete the prescribed nomination form and inform the nominee for approval
2. Submit form to the Secretariat of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists or CAP national representative.
3. The form must be submitted to CAP no later than **July 30th, 2011**
4. The decision will be made by the Executive Council of the Caribbean Association of Pharmacists.
5. The Executive Council reserves the right to make a nomination
6. The announcement of the winner will be made during the Annual Awards ceremony
7. The decision of the Executive Council shall be final

N.B. All persons who have accepted nominations must arrange to be present during the Awards Ceremony, August 13th, 2011, in Antigua or inform CAP of the name of their representative.
